The Print Shop is so easy to use, you probably won't need to read the whole manual to get started. Just start up the program and follow the prompts that appear on the screen. For quick reference, this card shows each of the fonts, summarizes the text entry commands, and lists the available Print Shop graphics by name and number.

TEXT ENTRY COMMANDS

Whenever The Print Shop asks you to enter your message, simply type in your text, line by line, and press RETURN at the end of each line. In addition, you may use the following keys:

RETURN	Moves cursor down to the next line. Press repeatedly to reach bottom of text entry window and to move on to next phase.	CTRL-S	Toggles size of text on a line: small or large. (Not available in Banner and Letterhead modes.)
ESC DELETE/	Moves cursor to previous line. Erases character to left of	CTRL-F	Toggles form of font on a line: solid, outline or 3-D. (3-D not available in Screen Magic and Banner modes.)
BACKSPACE CTRL-E	cursor. Erases entire line indicated by cursor. May be used to cancel or erase any line of	CTRL-P	Toggles position of a line: center, left or right. (Not available in Banner mode.)
